The minutes from the previous committee meeting were approved.

The committee met to discuss the formation of the Human Rights Commission that was established by Ordinance with the passage of the Human Rights Ordinance in April.

The Commission will be comprised of five residents, serving staggered 3 year terms. Initial terms will range from 1-3 years in order to stagger the terms, but thereafter each commission member will serve for three years. The mayor and the manager agreed to relinquish their first appointments in order to open the commission up to the entire community and to aspire to a balanced board.

Amberley will publicize the open commission seats in the newsletter, ice cream social, JCC farmers market, and Adath Israel Kosher BBQ. Interested parties can submit an application and interviews will be conducted. We hope to have final selections by October, and announcement by the November council meeting.
