

STREETS, PUBLIC UTILITIES and SEWER COMMITTEE MINUTES
March 20, 2014

Attendees: Rich Bardach (committee member), Bill Doering, Wes Brown, Ray Warren (committee member), Tom Muething, Natalie Wolf and Scot Lahrmer.

Minutes from February 6th, and March 6th were approved. Motion by Bardach and seconded by Warren

Manager presented copy of proposed resolution for support of State Issue 1 for the renewal of the State of Ohio Capital Improvements Program. This Issue was first approved by the voters in 1987 and renewed in 1995 and 2005. Would authorize state to issue \$1.875 in bonds for community road, bridge, sewer, water and other infrastructure projects. Will not require any new taxes. Funds could be either loans or grants to local communities. In the past Amberley has received \$984K in funds for various projects. After discussion it was recommended that Council support the issue rather than recommending residents vote for the issue. Residents should decide on their own how to vote for an issue after obtaining proper information and knowing if council supports the issue. Motion by Warren and seconded by Bardach to support State issue 1. Passed unanimously.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
