RESOLUTION NO. 2020-18

RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE MANAGER TO EXECUTE ANY DOCUMENTS FOR THE PURPOSE OF MAKING REPAIRS TO THE TENNIS COURTS AT THE MUNICIPAL BUILDING

WHEREAS, during a recent storm on April 8 the fence surrounding the tennis courts at the Municipal Building was damaged as were the tennis courts;

WHEREAS, the Village has submitted a claim to American Zurich Insurance Company (“American Zurich”) for damage assessment;

WHEREAS, the quote from Harry Ewers and Sons to repair and recoat the tennis court surface is not to exceed \$18,000;

WHEREAS, American Zurich will issue a check for approximately \$28,000, reflecting our \$1,000 deductible, to mitigate the damages. After we provide confirmation that the work has been completed, American Zurich will forward an additional amount of \$8,491 to the Village;

WHEREAS, the Public Buildings and Parks Committee recommends passage of this resolution;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE Council of Amberley Village, State of Ohio, seven (7) members elected thereto concurring:

SECTION 1: The Village Council hereby authorizes the Village Manager to execute any and all documents for the purpose of repairing the tennis courts at the municipal building.

SECTION 2: This Resolution shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
